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### **Cockshoot Broad Water Trail**

Thursdays and Sundays from June to August at 10.15am – 1 hour 45 minute trip  
Journey up the beautiful River Bure in the Bure Marshes National Nature Reserve to the very secluded and tranquil Cockshoot Broad. A short walk from the boat takes you down the boardwalk alongside the dyke where you may see damselflies and dragonflies resting on the abundant water lilies. Continue on to a bird hide where you may even chance upon an osprey which are known to visit this quiet refuge in the heart of the broads. Arrival by boat to the top of Cockshoot dyke is currently the only way to access this hidden wildlife haven.
