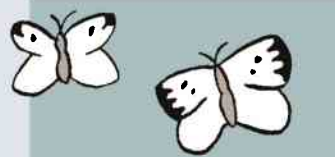


# Grow vegetables for wildlife

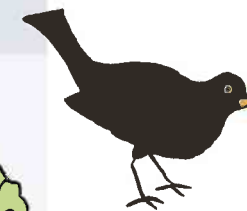

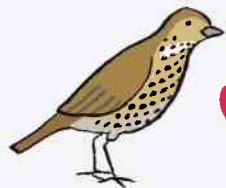

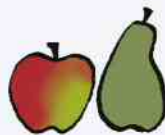
